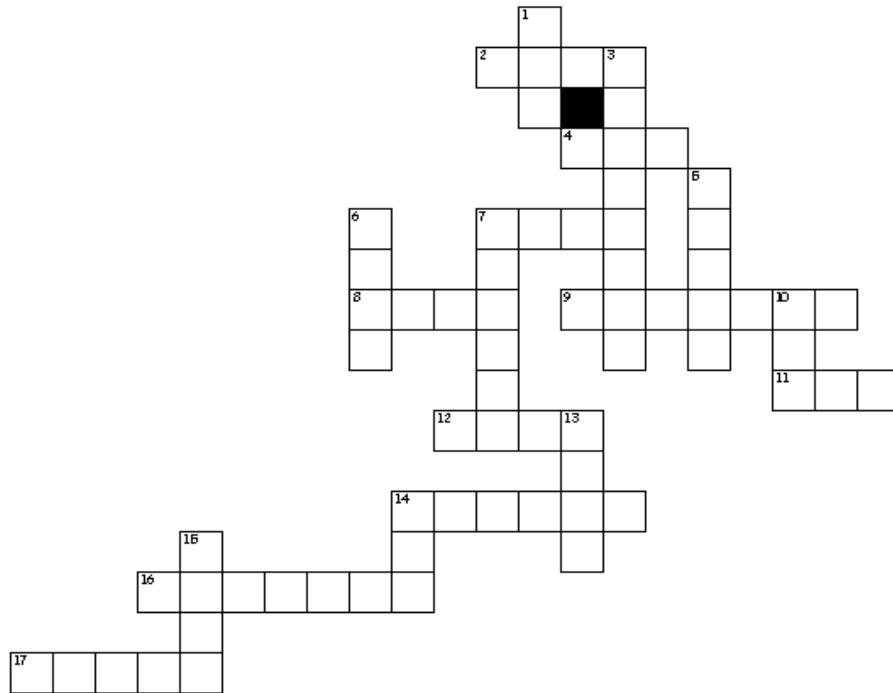


Parts of the body

2. The mouth of a person or animal, especially a large and fierce animal.
4. One of the jointed extensions on the end of the foot in humans and other vertebrates,
7. An animal's rearmost part, usually an appendage and extension of the spinal column.
8. The thin, pliable tissue covering the animal or human body.
9. One of the structures forming the plumage of birds.
11. The organ of hearing.
12. The hard structures forming a bird's bill.
14. One of the five jointed members at the end of the hand.
16. A wide flat limb useful for swimming, as on a whale or turtle.
17. The bend or joint between the human upper arm and forearm, or the bony projection at this bend.

1. The foot of a four-legged animal, especially one with claws.
3. The part of the human body extending from the base of the neck to either upper arm.
5. The opening in the face through which one eats, breathes, speaks and emits vocal sounds, and which includes the lips, teeth and tongue.
6. The structure at the front of the face in people and certain animals that contains nostrils, organs of smell and a passageway for breathing.
7. The fleshy movable organ in the bottom of the mouth used for licking, tasting, swallowing and human speech.
10. The organ of sight and the area close around it, including the lids, lashes and brow.
13. The joint between the upper and lower portions of the human leg.
14. The soft thick hair that covers the bodies of certain animals.
15. A slender, sharp usually curved nail on the foot of an animal.
